Over the year we have welcomed a number of new students and their families to our school and hope you really enjoy being a part of our community. I have attached the HPS Guide 2024 to the newsletter as a practical guide. Please can I remind all families about absence and lateness and the importance of ensuring students are 'on time' and that all absences must be accounted for via SENTRAL. Please note the following:

- 'Ten to 9, be on time' Our school day begins at 8.50am with the students heading into the learning environment and organising themselves for the day. This initiative has been very successful this year and supports a calm and on-time start to the learning programs – thank you for your support with this.
- 'Late arrivals and early pick-up': Parents are expected to sign their child in or out at the office. 
